NON-TRIVIAL WOMEN:

Erica, Gladys and Debra

In Maryland and other states, women like these ... don't count.

- ◆ Teenager Erica Kae Richardson bled to death within hours of her abortion.
- ◆ Gladys Estanislao's ectopic pregnancy went undiagnosed during her abortion and later ruptured causing her to bleed to death.
- ◆ Debra Gray died from anesthesia-related complications three days after her abortion.

Each year, abortion-related deaths go unacknowledged and unsafe practices continue. State statistics showed no abortion-related deaths for 1989, the year these and other Maryland women had their abortions. The CDC reported only 12 such deaths nationwide that year, as though these and similar untold stories ... don't count.

Abortion is a poor choice and women deserve better.
